A special "Thank You" to the ushers of our parish who took the time during the month of October to conduct the annual "**October count**" of all those who attend our church on Sundays. We averaged 580 people each weekend who worshipped here at OLQA. That's about the same as in previous years, so we are definitely "holding our own." These numbers are sent to the diocese and are used whenever there should be a study of consolidations, closings, or rearranging of Mass schedules.
