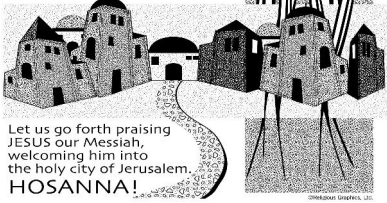

This is **HOLY WEEK**, the holiest week of our church year. Nothing is more important than the events and liturgies of our parish this next week. Please make them a priority in your week this week. As you open yourselves to the prayer of this week, your faith will increase beyond your imaginations! Walking through these events will help us all appreciate more all that Christ did for us and for our salvation. There will be a **SEDER MEAL** celebration on Wednesday evening at 6:00. It's the perfect way to enter into the sacredness of the following days. **MORNING PRAYER** will be prayed each day (Thursday, Friday, and Saturday) at 9:00. We pray the Liturgy of the Hours at that time, lasting about 20 minutes. The **MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER** will be celebrated Thursday evening at 7:00. This includes the presentation of the new oils to be used this year, the washing of the feet, the remembrance of the Last Supper and the institution of the priesthood, and the procession with the Blessed Sacrament around the church and into the hall, our repository for the evening. Come and pray in the hall from after the Mass until 10:00 P.M. **STATIONS OF THE CROSS** will be prayed Good Friday at 12:00 noon. The **LITURGY OF THE LORD'S PASSION** will be celebrated Friday at 2:00. This beautiful ceremony includes the Passion, the reception of Eucharist, and the veneration of the cross. The **EASTER VIGIL** begins Saturday at 8:30 P.M. Every Church in the diocese will begin the vigil this year at that time. We bless the new fire and honor the new Easter Candle. As we watch for the resurrection, we will renew our own Baptismal promises, watching the baptism of new converts and the welcoming into the full communion of our church of other candidates. These nine will receive the Eucharist for the first time on Saturday evening and some will be confirmed. As they join our church and celebrate

These sacraments for the first time, we renew our own appreciation of the sacraments and our oneness around the Table of the Lord.
